RECYCLING CENTER STICKERS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Is this an annual Fee?** Yes. Every year in June the new Fiscal Year (July 1 – June 30) Sticker will be available for purchase at the Rockland Board of Health Office located within Town Hall.
- **What is the Annual Fee?**
 - \$10.00 Residents that are on Town's curbside collection (**FY22 Red Sticker**)
 - \$20.00 Residents that are **not** on Town's curbside collection (**FY22 Black Sticker**)
- **How many stickers can 1 household obtain?** Two (2) Stickers are allowed per household and must be purchased at the current annual fee.
- **What do I need to provide to obtain sticker?** You must be a Rockland resident and you must provide the vehicle registration for each car that you are requesting a sticker for.
- **Where can I obtain a Sticker?** Sticker may be obtained at the Rockland Board of Health Office only.
- **Can I purchase sticker at the RRC directly?** No, at this time stickers can not be purchased at the Rockland Recycling Center (RRC).
- **Why can't I purchase my sticker at the Rockland Recycling Center (RRC)?** RRC stickers have a cash value and are considered a fixed asset. Therefore, strict tracking of these stickers is required, which the current staffing and technology at the RRC cannot provide.
- **Will my ID still be checked?** No. The sticker program will replace the ID checking. Recycling Center Staff will verify that the sticker matches the license plate.
- **Where do I display my sticker?** Lower driver side of windshield.
- **Do I have to purchase a sticker?** Yes, if you want to utilize the facility.
- **What will the fee be used for?** Maintaining the facility, including rising disposal costs.
- **Can I use my voucher to purchase sticker?** No, vouchers can only be used towards disposal.
